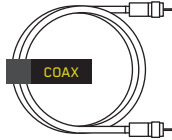

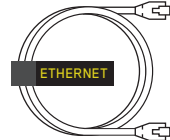

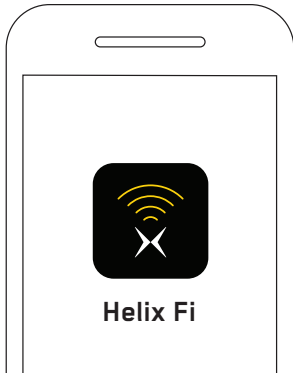

Gateway installation options

Option A

Download the free **Helix Fi** app on your mobile.

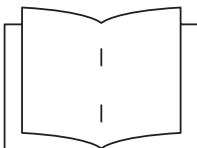
It will show you how to install, set up and use your gateway.

Install your gateway with the help of this guide.



Follow the steps on the following pages.

1. Uninstall old equipment.

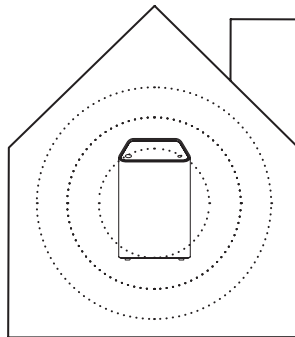
Before you start installing your Helix gateway, uninstall and set aside your old service devices (if applicable):

- Internet modem
- Wi-Fi router
- illico TV terminal

2. Position your gateway.

Position the gateway near the most centrally located Videotron coaxial outlet.

To optimize the Wi-Fi signal, place your gateway on a piece of furniture.

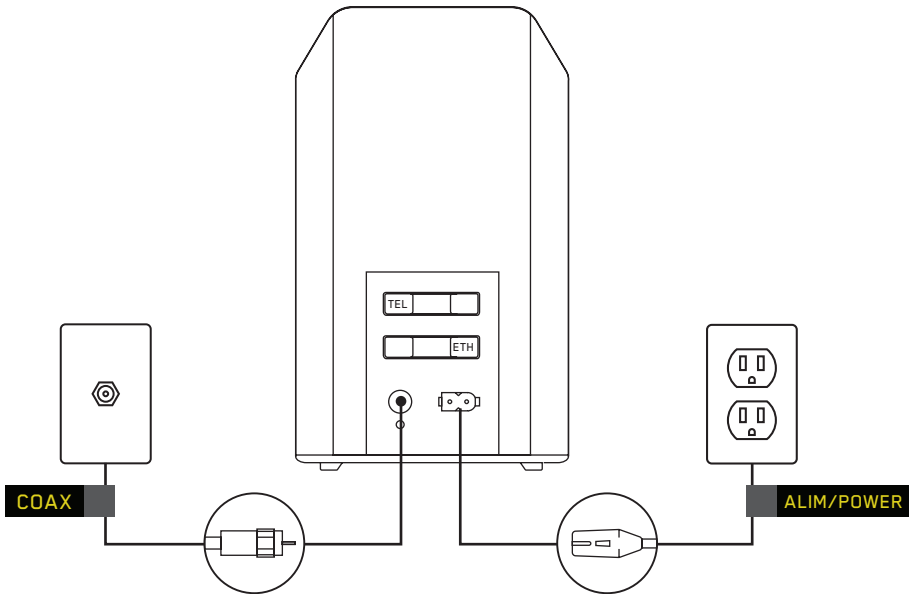


Place the gateway in a central, unobstructed area.

3. Connect your gateway.

Securely connect the provided **coaxial cable** to the gateway and to the wall outlet.

Plug the **power cord** into your gateway and into a power outlet not controlled by a dimmer or wall switch.



Want to use the Internet without using Wi-Fi?

Connect the **Ethernet cable** to the gateway and plug it into the Ethernet port of the device you want to connect (the lights next to the Ethernet port on the back of the gateway should turn on).

4. Wait...



5-20 minutes

Start-up can take up to 20 minutes **if a software update is required.**

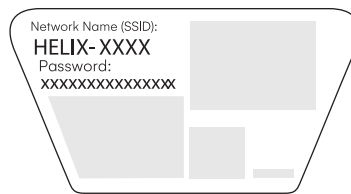
A light on top of the gateway will flash and go from orange to green. Keep the gateway plugged in.

Wait for the light to turn white before continuing the installation.

5. Connect to the gateway using Wi-Fi.

Go to Wi-Fi settings on your mobile or computer **to connect to the temporary Wi-Fi network.**

The **network name** and temporary **password** are found on the bottom of your gateway.

Is the light staying orange or green?

Check that your gateway is properly plugged into the coaxial wall outlet.

Call us if the problem persists (see our contact information at the end of the instructions).

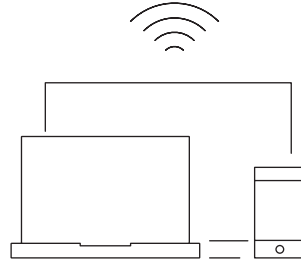
6. Activate and set up your Wi-Fi network.

Once logged in, open a web browser. Type 10.0.0.1 in the address bar if your web browser does not go there automatically.

To make sure you don't forget **your new network name and password**, write them down here.

7. Connect your devices to the new Wi-Fi network.



To use Wi-Fi on all your devices, connect them to your **new Wi-Fi network** using your **new password**.

Go to your favourite website and test your new Wi-Fi connection.

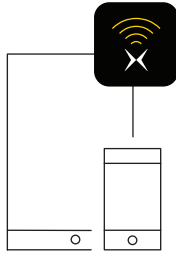

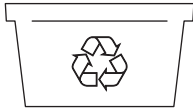
Four eco-friendly tips



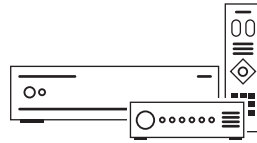
Don't throw out the Velcro!

gift wrap, etc.



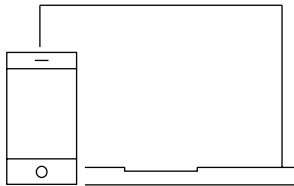
Is your box damaged?
